ADMISSION PROCESS

APPLICATION

All candidates seeking admission to degree programmes should compulsorily register through CAP (Centralized Admission Process). The registration procedures will be made by the college office. Candidates without CAP registration are not eligible for admission.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA

For admission in management quota students have to submit application in the prescribed form recommended and signed by any one of the Directors of the Management Committee. The application form can be had from the college office on payment of Rs. 150/ Students selected under merit quota also have to submit college application form at the time of admission.

INTERVIEW

At the time of interview students should bring their CAP Admit Card. In case of Management Quota, the candidates will have to bring CAP ID Number. Students have to report before the Principal with his/her parent/guardian for the interview with the following documents

All Original documents submitted at the time of admission will be returned only after completion of the course and after clearing the dues. Sufficient attested copies of the qualifying certificates should be retained by the students for their future use.

UNIFORM & ID CARD

The prescribed uniform & College ID cards are compulsory in the campus on all days.

ANTI-RAGGING

Ragging is strictly prohibited on campus. Students are warned that as per the provisions of the Kerala prohibition of ragging Act 1998 and the order of university of Calicut, ragging within or outside the college is strictly punishable.
